



KINGSVILLE'S SIXTH ANNUAL **WILD GOOSE 4 X 4 EVENT**

What's a "4X4"?

... An afternoon of curling skill development **guaranteed** to improve your game while being a whole lot of fun!

Two **groups** of four teams (up to 8 teams in total) play 4 games of four ends each. All four members on each team rotate through all four positions from game to game. "Tankard" scoring system: scores of each colour pooled (added together) across all four sheets.

6 rocks per team per end. First stone pre-placed – hammer team's stone pre-placed on the centerline in the middle of the back four-foot, non-hammer team's stone pre-placed as centerline guard one broom handle length in front of the house. "Skip" throws second and sixth stone. Vice throws third, fourth and fifth stones. Sweepers sweep all 20 rocks in the game (that is until the next game, then change positions). And Graeme has a "new twist" for us this year too!

These games go very quickly with lots of interesting "strategy"...
Lots of repetition so great for developing and improving skills.

Who?... Anyone interested in improving their curling skills (would help any curler at all skill levels) **and/or** folk looking for a fun-filled afternoon activity.
